The 2009 Social Season at PYC is coming to a close. The only event remaining on our Social events calendar is the annual Christmas Dinner Dance to be hosted by Glen and Mary Lou Graper at the Portsmouth Country Club on December 12, 2009.

From my point of view the 2009 Social Season at PYC was very successful. Our 16 Wednesday Night Dinners averaged just under 80 members and guests per night. Our Special Wednesday Night Dinners averaged 111 members and guests; the two Lobster Bakes also averaged 111 members and guests; our Breakfast/Brunch events averaged 113 members and guests; our Opening and Closing Dinner Dances averaged 87 members and guests and our Cocktail parties averaged 116 members and guests. 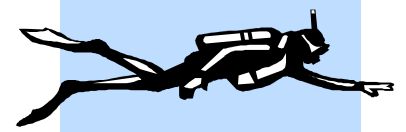
